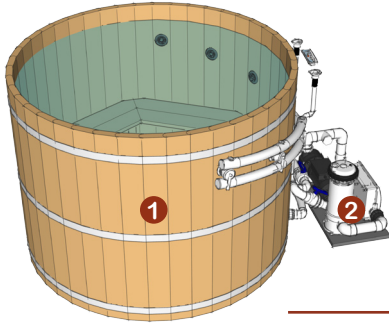


# Selecting the right hot tub configuration

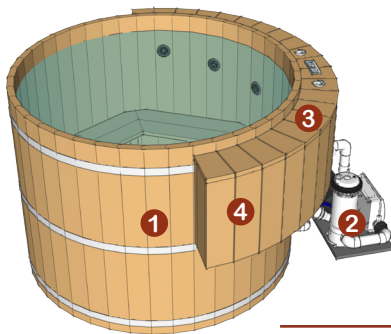
Built-in, semi built-in, or standalone ? Or yet another...

There are many ways to integrate a hot tub in your garden. Some of the most popular configurations are **Built-in**, **Semi Built-in** and **Standalone**, as displayed herebelow. Obviously, there are many more possible setups. We will gladly assist you in putting together the right configuration for your project.



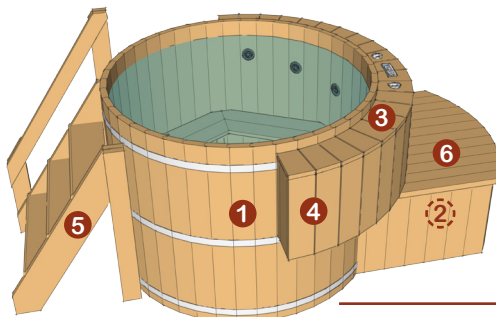
Install your hot tub (1) fully into a deck. Leave the top rim out for min. 5 cm for the insulation cover. The controls can be mounted directly into the decking next to the hot tub. Place the spa-system (2) below the deck with a hatch for easy access to the filter. Ideally the hot tub and the spa-system are installed first and then the deck is constructed around it.

## BUILT-IN



Install your hot tub (1) half into a deck. Place the spa-system (2) below the deck with a hatch for easy access. The side shelves (3) are pre-drilled to mount the controls. The side skirting (4) provide a beautiful all-cedar finish. Ideally the hot tub and the spa-system are installed first and then the deck is constructed around it. Finally, the side shelves and skirting are installed. The height of the skirting can be adjusted to fit the actual height of the deck.

## SEMI BUILT-IN



Install your hot tub (1) on a patio. The enclosure (6) protects the spa-system (2) from the elements. The side shelves (3) are pre-drilled to mount the controls. The side skirting (4) provides a beautiful all-cedar finish. Add the stairs (5) to step in and out of your hot tub easily.
